<p>The City will provide funds for emergency repairs to ensure the availability of safe housing for low/mod income households in owner occupied structures. Funds will be used for emergency assistance for major deficiencies, including roof repair and furnace replacement. Target areas include 18th & 19th St., the Mid City NRSA, Masten District and Kensington Bailey area. The City has extended its contracts with its community based organizations to deliver its rehab program. No units have been completed during this quarter. Street improvements will be done in low/mod areas of the City. The City plans to complete street improvements on approx. 16 streets throughout the City. During this quarter, the City completed the bidding process for \$1,000,000 in street improvements. The City plans to complete approx. 26 demolitions throughout the City. The City is currently in the process of developing the bid work for its demolitions. A Jobs Training Program will assist low to moderate income persons with employment training in the construction trades industry.</p>
